Concept Note (Hindi)

मानव जीवन का मूल आधार मानवता है। मानवता वह मूल्य-व्यवस्था है जो व्यक्ति को जैविक अस्तित्व से ऊपर उठाकर संवेदनशील, सहृदय तथा सामाजिक प्राणी बनती है। वर्तमान युग में विज्ञान, प्रौद्योगिकी, वैश्विकरण और सूचना विस्फोट ने जहाँ एक ओर अभूतपूर्व प्रगति के द्वार खोले हैं, वहीं दूसरी ओर मानवीय संवेदनाओं के ह्रास, नैतिक मूल्यों के क्षरण, भौतिकवादी प्रवृत्तियाँ और सांस्कृतिक विघटन आदि सामने आए हैं। बदलते सामाजिक, राजनीतिक, आर्थिक तथा तकनिकी परिदृश्य में आज मानवता का स्वरूप अनेक चुनौतियों से घिरा हुआ दिखाई देता है।
